



Unjust Suffering: Insights and Practical Principles

(Not an exusted list of passages)

#1) Because of sin, unjust suffering exists (Genesis 3, Romans 8:20–21)

#2) Unjust suffering is planned/permitted by God (Genesis 50:20, Job 1-2, 1 Peter 2:21, Colossians 1:24–26, 2 Timothy 3:12)

#3) Unjust suffering requires patience, prayer, and perseverance (1 Peter 2:23, 1 Peter 4:19, James 1:2–8)

#4) Unjust suffering is the vehicle for the Gospel (Hebrews 11, Romans 8:18–30)

#5) Unjust suffering is for the redemption of some and condemnation of others (Revelation 6:9–11)

#6) God will reward those who are faithful to Him who suffer unjustly (Hebrews 2:9, Revelation 2:10, Revelation 22:12–13)

#7) Being Faith while suffering unjustly glorifies God (1 Peter 4:14, 1 Peter 4:16)

May we remember the exhortation of Paul...

Romans 8:18 For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us.
